Spatial intersection, volumetric form, accessibility

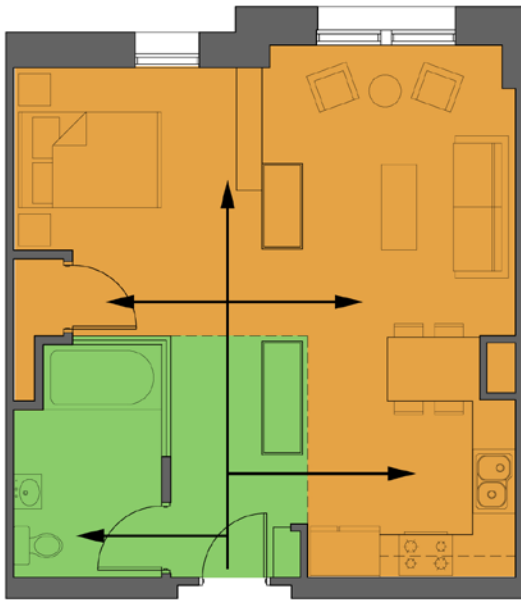
Design Strategies

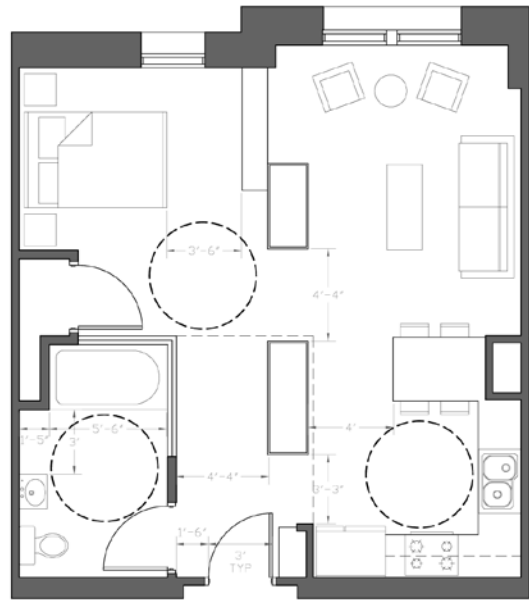

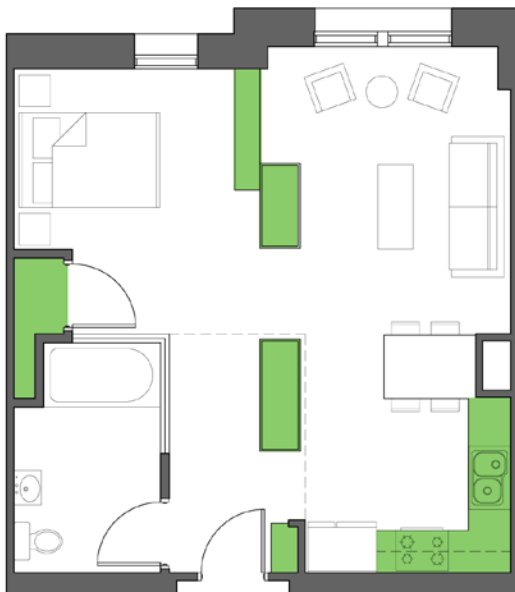

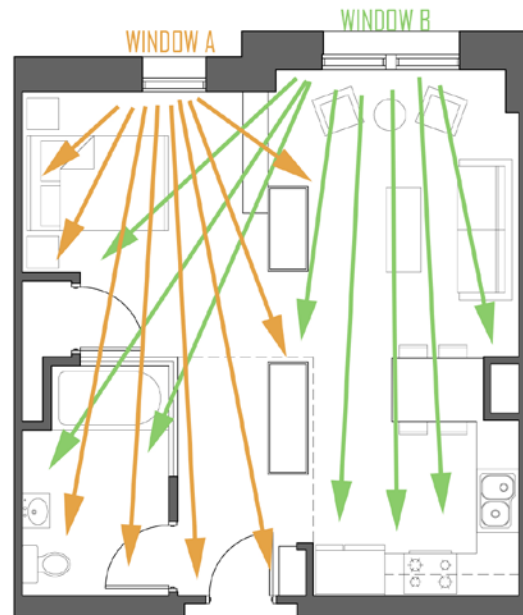
VOLUME AND MOVEMENT DIAGRAM 1/4" = 1'-0"
